

Thread Lift Pre/Post Care

Pre-Care Instructions To Follow For Your Thread Lift Appointment:

Follow this guideline BEFORE each treatment

- Three days prior to procedure, avoid all supplements, vitamins, green tea, and **NO anti-inflammatory drugs** i.e. Advil or Ibuprofen.
- Take 2 Tylenol extra strength an hour prior to procedure and take as needed after procedure.
- Eat a good breakfast and hydrate well on the morning of the procedure.
- No alcohol 48 hours before treatment.
- Avoid strenuous exercise for 4-7 days after the procedure, avoid yoga poses like downward dog.
- Avoid heat such as hot baths and saunas for 24 hours.
- Wash your face normally.
- It is recommended to put a clean pillow case on to avoid contamination through existing oil, dirt and make-up.
- Gentle upward massage with your face cream is recommended.
- Avoid eating chewy / tough foods such as steak as this may be uncomfortable for the first day or two.

Post-Care Instructions:

Follow this guideline AFTER each treatment

- It may take up to 2 weeks or more for the treatment area to become noticeable
- One should expect to be sore, swollen, and/or bruised post procedure.
- Ice is a great anti-inflammatory! Practice 15 mins on and 15 mins off as needed for the days post procedure. It is also common to take Tylenol as needed.
- Dimpling, asymmetry, and irregularity of the tissue is normal and will resolve.
- Injection site pain is normal and may last up to I week after treatment.
- If there is puckering of the skin in the treated areas, gently massage often to release.
- If any thread becomes exposed or starts to extrude it is best to contact your practitioner to resolve.



- Avoid exercise, hot tubs, or saunas for 24 hours. You should stay away from any excessive sweating during this time.
- Avoid strenuous activity (such as high intensity workouts and contact sports) for 48-72 hours after.
- Eating foods like a steak or a large burger right after treatment may be uncomfortable!
